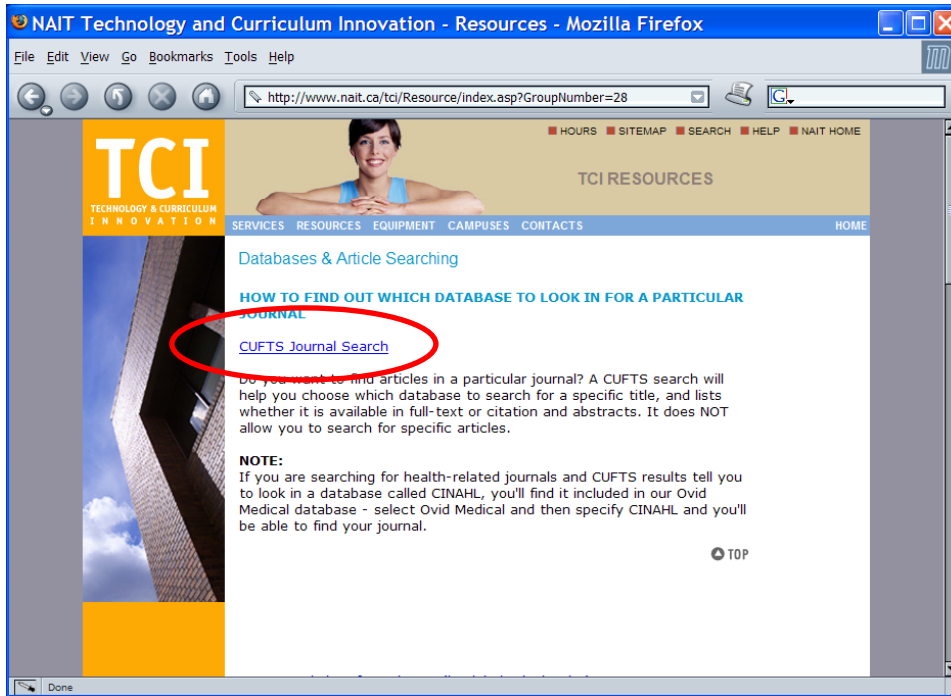

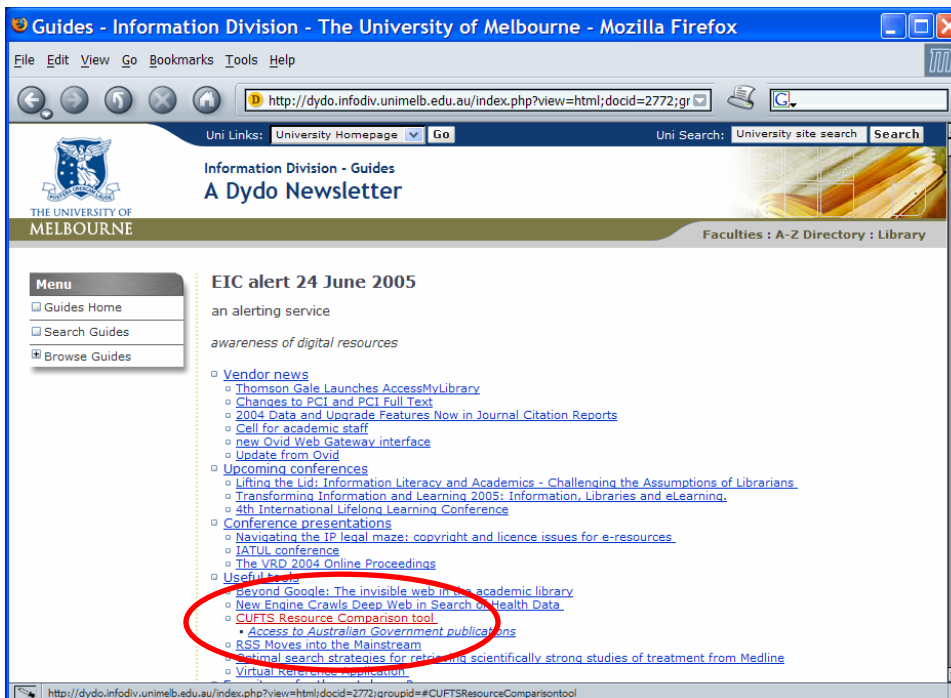

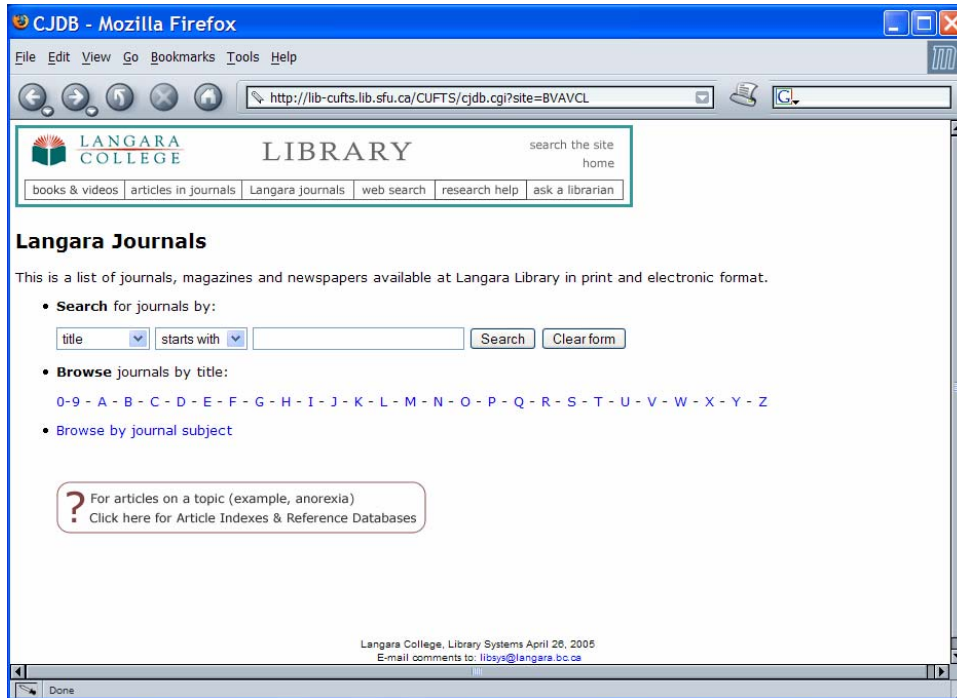

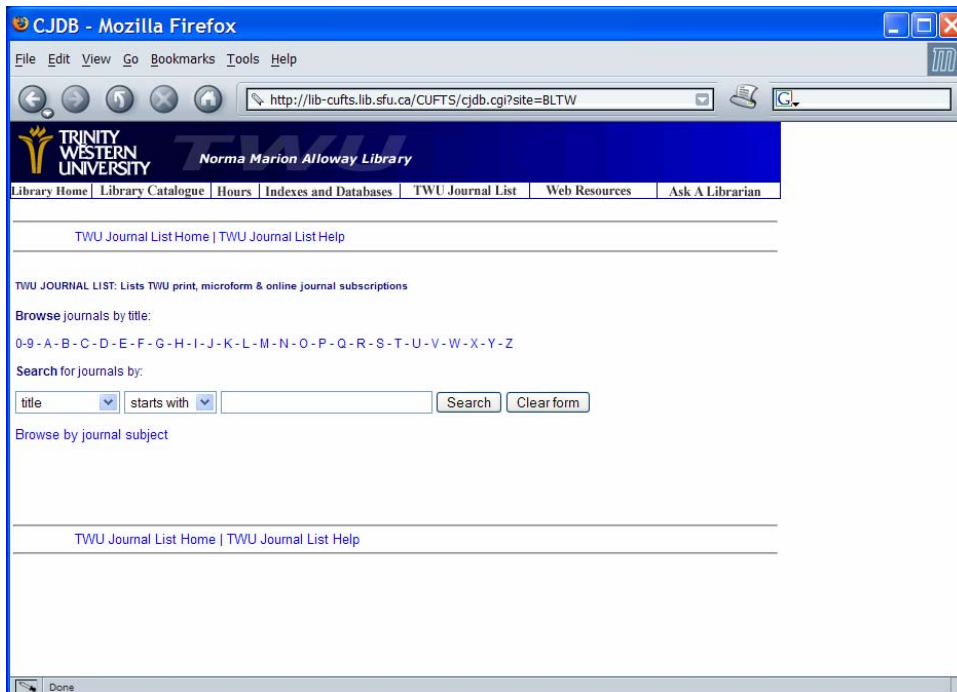
## CUFTS Resource Comparison: University of Melbourne, Australia
